**The prices included here are all with UF contracts/vendors (except The Dollar Tree), so we were able to get reduced prices for some items.

Each kit cost about \$100 the way we made them.

However, the bulk of the cost is color copies and lamination. You can reduce the price per kit depending on how much you choose to print in color and laminate. Example: For Activity #7, Carbon on the Move, we included 8 color signs and 8 b/w signs, all laminated. So the signs for that activity were \$18.62 total per kit. Without lamination, this would be \$4.22 per kit. And we didn't compare the cost of buying supplies to laminate ourselves, but that is another option.

You can also reduce cost by not including materials for all the activities that we did. We had items for Activities 1, 7, 8, 9, 11, and 12. I would definitely suggest you include items for the two carbon activities (# 7 and #8) and the timeline (#1).

The expanding file folder is nice, but not necessary of course! We started by using really big manila envelopes to store everything and that could work too, but we found they were not sturdy and could not be closed and reopened effectively.
